Procedures and rules:

1. Each practice begins with a snack (when you check in at the cafeteria) then announcements.
2. Students must be here on their practice days, and should NOT be here on days they do not have practice. (teachers and bus drivers will have lists)
3. Absences are considered excused if they are on the original sign up, if we have a written note, or if student is sick from school that day.
4. Students will remain in the lunchroom in their assigned areas (or in practice rooms with the teacher)
5. Students should bring homework, AR book, etc., for any time they are off stage and waiting for their turn to rehearse.
6. Younger students must be signed out by a parent/guardian/adult at the end of practice. Grades 6 and up may sign themselves out. If parents would rather older kids wait for you, just let us know.
7. Parents/family members may wait in the pit if they are here early during early rehearsals.
8. Students should have fun, but need to behave appropriately.
9. No phones on stage; electronics are brought at your own risk.

We reserve the right to take away parts if students do not follow the rules. Our policy is “3 strikes,” giving students warnings before they have to be left out. We will inform parents of any warnings. (Serious issues go immediately to strike three)

Remember: We work around your schedule until the last week. Actors may NOT miss the week of February 11th.
