

## Accountability Process Timeline

By September 1	<p>School-level accountability committee adopts building goals/objectives and a plan to improve educational achievement, maximize graduation rates and increase the ratings for the school's accreditation category. <i>(C.R.S. 22-7-205(1))</i></p> <p>Goals/objectives and plans reviewed by district accountability committee and recommendations submitted to Board. <i>(C.R.S. 22-7-205(1))</i></p>
By October 1	<p>After consultation with district accountability committee, Board compiles school building goals/objectives and plans and reports to the public the district's goals/objectives and the district's plan to improve educational achievement, maximize graduation rates and increase the ratings for each school's accreditation category. <i>(C.R.S. 22-7-205(2))</i></p>
By December 1	<p>Board disseminates a written report to the taxpayers and local community regarding progress on district and school accreditation indicators. The report shall be made available to the State Board of Education, the general assembly, the governor and the public at large. <i>(C.R.S. 22-11-105(2))</i> <i>(1 CCR 301-1, Rules 2202-R 0.00)</i></p>
After January 15	<p>Within a reasonable time after completion of the state accountability report, each school shall notify the parents/guardians of each student enrolled in the school of the availability on the Internet of the state accountability report. Printed copies of the report will be made available, upon request, to parents and members of the public. A school-generated report may be included or inserted in the state accountability report as long as the school report does not refute information included in the state report. <i>(C.R.S. 22-7-606)</i></p>
Prior to adopting budget for fiscal year	<p>School-level accountability committees make recommendations to Board, district accountability committee and superintendent relative to prioritization of expenditures of district moneys by each school. <i>(C.R.S. 22-7-207)</i></p>

Superintendent considers recommendations by school level committees when formulating budget requests presented to Board.  
*(C.R.S. 22-7-207)*

Board considers recommendations prior to adopting budget.  
*(C.R.S. 22-7-105)*
