It also strengthens the morale of all concerned to know that preparedness plans exist and that students and staff have been trained in carrying them out.

Therefore, the superintendent shall be responsible for developing plans that meet state and local requirements for preparedness in case of fire, civil emergencies, tornadoes and other disasters.
