

Temporary School Facilities

It is the intent of the Board to have sufficient permanent facilities to meet the needs of school enrollment and the school program.

If circumstances require immediate space which is not available in public school buildings, facilities may be rented and portable structures used only as a temporary, emergency measure. Any such facility must conform to all appropriate state and local building and land use codes, health and fire laws and environmental standards.
