

Evaluation of Evaluators

Provision shall be made for periodic evaluation of evaluators of professional staff to ensure that the process is being carried out in a fair, professional and credible manner.

All persons who evaluate professional staff members shall possess a principal or administrator license issued by the Colorado Department of Education and shall have received education and training in evaluation skills approved by the department. Issuance or renewal of a license requires that the applicant has received such approved education and training in evaluation skills.

Evaluation instruments for all professional staff administrators shall include a section dealing with their evaluation skills and responsibilities. The superintendent or designee shall review all evaluations done by administrators and when necessary shall discuss with them procedure and form.

The superintendent's evaluation skills shall be part of the evaluation by the Board of Education.
