

Nonschool Employment of Professional Staff

The Board recognizes teaching or other educational work with outside agencies as professional growth.

Any other type of outside work by staff members shall warrant the attention of the Board only as it may directly prevent the staff member from properly performing his or her assigned functions during duty hours or be prejudicial to his or her effectiveness in the professional position.
