

Support Staff Career Development

Support staff members are an integral part of the district's total staff. Their training and development are essential to the efficient and economical operation of the schools.

Therefore, the support staff shall be encouraged to grow in job skills. It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to facilitate the training of custodians, clerks and other classified employees. The dates of all inservice programs shall be included in the district or individual school calendars.

Absences to attend meetings, conventions, conferences or workshops of local, state or national associations which serve to advance the welfare of the district through the upgrading and strengthening of the support staff may be approved by the superintendent.
