

## ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

Enrollment of Non-resident students will be limited to the Colorado Department of Education annual October count date.

Non-resident students will be subject to a background check with their previous school(s). This check may include attendance, discipline history, outstanding fines, grades, credits earned and any special needs.

Recommendation as to acceptance or denial of admission to Swink Schools will be made within a reasonable period of time after the application has been submitted.

Non-resident students may be denied admission if their enrollment would cause over-crowding of classroom space. Enrollment is on a year to year basis. Non-resident students attending Swink Schools for the longest continuous period of enrollment will be given preferential consideration for attendance if non-resident students must be excluded due to availability of space.
