

Extracurricular Activity Eligibility

The following rules shall govern participation in all school-approved extracurricular activities:

1. Participants must be full-time middle school or high school students in courses that will earn three Carnegie units of credit per semester or enrolled in a nonpublic home-based program or an independent or parochial school taking an equivalent number of classes.
2. Students enrolled in the district must be in attendance at school for the entire school day in order to participate in any school-sponsored activity that is conducted on that day. In cases of emergency or extenuating circumstances, the principal or his designee may grant an exception to this limitation. The attendance requirement will not apply to other students since the district cannot effectively monitor their daily attendance.
3. An eligibility list will be made available on Monday. Students who receive one failing grade or three D's for the week will not be eligible to participate during that week of activities. The athletic director will certify individual student eligibility. Students participating in activities who are not enrolled in the district must provide appropriate certification stating that the academic eligibility requirements have been met.
4. Students must submit a physical examination statement to the school before participating in any sport.
5. Students must have emergency treatment, parent permission and athletic insurance waiver forms signed and on file with the school before being allowed to practice in a sport or participate in any activity.
6. Students violating the district code of conduct will be ineligible until they have complied with all disciplinary sanctions.
